<b>Tempranillo Laguna de la Nava, Reserva Bodegas Navarro, Spain 2009</b> <i>A Reserva wine must legally see a minimum of 36 months in cask or bottle with minimum 12 months in cask. This wine spent 12 months in French (60%) and American (40%) oak barriques before bottling to add body and spice, with a further 2 years bottle ageing to soften tannins and add complexity. # MALT WHISKY

As the national drink of Scotland, whisky is available in many bars across Edinburgh. We feel the 'nips' and 'drams' available at 10 Wine Bar can give any visitor an insight into the enthusiasm behind whisky, or entertain a seasoned whisky enthusiast for a while.

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## A Bit Special

If you are already familiar with Scotch whisky, or perhaps you would like to sample the most extravagant of Scotland's malty offerings, you may want to try these terrific drams!

### Speyside:

#### Macallan (18 y.o.)

**£10.50**

*Another fantastic malt from Macallan, this fantastic whisky is finished in Sherry casks to give it a rich and sweet taste.*

### Lowland:

#### Glenkinchie Distillers edition

**£5.65**

*A lovely whisky from Lowland distillers Glenkinchie, this special malt has tastes of sweetness and a warm nuttiness that will satisfy any whisky connoisseur.*

### Highland:

#### Glenmorangie (18 y.o.)

**£7.25**

*From the world famous Glenmorangie stills comes this special 18 year old malt. It will not disappoint!*

### Islay:

#### Bruichladdich Organic

**£5.65**

*Made with organic Scottish barley, and as you would expect from the region a lightly peated malt matured in bourbon casks.*

## Islay

Nicknamed "whisky island", Islay produces very peaty, smoky malts, resulting in strong, dry whisky. The strong character of these whiskies can mean they are quite polarizing, and those who enjoy them do so with a passion!

#### Ardbeg (10 y.o.)

**£4.95**

*Said to be the smokiest, most peated whisky in the world, Ardbeg is a tippie of polarity: opening with tangy citrus flavours, it then develops into smokey, toasted notes of coffee and liquorice.*

#### Bunnahabhain (12 y.o.)

**£4.95**

*As is common for Islay whiskies, Bunnabhain opens with smoky fruit and nut flavours that produce a sweet, lingering finish.*

#### Jura (10 y.o.)

**£4.95**

*This is a great starting point for anyone wishing to start their journey into Scotch whisky. The flavours of oak, honey and toffee round out this light, balanced malt.*

#### Laphroaig (10 y.o.)

**£4.95**

*Laphroaig comes on strong with smoke and seaweed on the nose. The palate is sweet and a little salty, with waves of peat washing out to a lasting finish. Savour it neat or with a splash of water to allow the flavours to open up.*

## Lowland

Lowland whiskies are lighter, softer, and more understated than other regions. There are only three distilleries in the lowlands, and we have decided to offer two of these at 10 Wine Bar.

### Glenkinchie (12 y.o.) **£4.95**

*This pale, medium-bodied golden malt starts off with floral sweetness developing into butter icing and cheesecake, with a dry, herbal finish.*

### Auchentoshan (12 y.o.) **£4.95**

*Auchentoshan is distilled three times for added smoothness; and as a result of this the subtle flavours of vanilla cream and green apples can be savoured with ease*

## Islands

Whisky made on the Scottish isles (apart from Islay) have a heavier peat than highland whiskies, but are softer and sweeter than the peated whiskies of Islay.

### Highland Park (12 y.o.) **£4.95**

*With a long and eventful past, the history of this Orkney distillery is entwined in every malt it creates. First bottled in 1979, this is a*

### Talisker (10 y.o.) **£4.95**

*As the only single malt whisky made on the isle of Skye, Talisker whisky was a favourite of the Scottish writer Robert Louis Stevenson. The 10 year old tippie has intense flavours of dried fruits and barley-malt, accompanied by the characteristic smokiness.*

## Speyside

Almost half of Scotland's distilleries are located within the Speyside region. The sweetest of all Scottish whisky malts, and subdivided into two main categories; the heavy, sherry-flavoured malts, and the lighter, complex fruity malts.

### Glen Moray **£4.95**

*Glen Moray use ex bourbon barrels sourced from North America to mature Glen Moray and these produce a whisky with rich and spicy characteristics. These casks deliver a superior product that has a smooth and well-rounded taste.*

### Balvenie (12 y.o.) **£4.95**

*Aged in ex-Bourbon and Sherry casks, this whisky has gentle spice with a little vanilla, and a dry, warming finish. A beautiful tasting whisky for such a young age.*

### Glenfiddich (12 y.o.) **£4.95**

*This whisky has certainly deserved its title as "the World's Most Awarded Single Malt Scotch whisky"; its characteristic fruity opening gives way to butterscotch, cream and oaky notes.*

### Glenfiddich (12 y.o.) **£4.95**

*In a remote part of the Highlands the Glenlivet distillery produces whisky using water from the natural spring "Josie's Well", resulting in a smooth, bright gold malt with strong flavours of pineapple and a nutty finish.*

## Highland

Whiskies from the largest whisky-producing region in Scotland can take a variety of forms, but are generally less peated than for example Islay Whiskies.

### Glenmorangie (10 y.o.) **£4.95**

*The original expression of Glenmorangie's extensive range, this delicate spirit is distilled in Scotland's tallest stills. Initial hints of vanilla give way to a burst of flowery fruitiness, a clean aftertaste with hints of orange and peach.*

Inspired by the story of a drayman's happy accident with a delivery of beer in Musselburgh just nearby, this brisk beer has notes of caramel, toffee and cocoa, with a smooth dry finish.

### Knops California Common 330ml **£4.25**

This style of beer was originally crafted to slake the thirst of miners during the Californian gold rush. It's hand crafted in small batches with the very best of ingredients. Light toffee notes followed by a lingering secondary bitterness hit that is refreshing rather than overwhelming.

### Knops India Pale Ale 330ml **£4.25**

A traditional Pale Ale, made hoppy and strong to withstand the high temperatures of long journeys around the world to Britain's far flung colonies, this offers refreshing citrus notes well balanced by the smooth honeyed malt backbone.
