The skin of a red grape is what gives a red wine both its colour and tannins. Light-bodied red wines are made from grape varieties with thinner and/or lighter skins than those grapes that make a fuller-bodied red. Don't fall for the red with meat, white with fish rule. Pinot Noir and other light wines can match really well with fish and especially poultry.
